

This week's sound is 'a'. Look on the Owls Blog for a video using the 'a' sound. Maybe you could try some apple printing at home?


So far I have made videos for 'm' and 'a'. You could try collecting 'm' and 'a' objects in your house and sorting them

'We are all different' -This is a great topic for cooking as we can explore likes and dislikes!




Sarah likes oranges, but she does not like bananas!




Em doesn't like carrots, but she likes carrot cake!

We work in communication all the time in Owls! There's a cooking communication board on the next page which you might find helpful.


You could use this table to sort some of the food in your house into 'like' and 'don't like'. We are all different, so some people in your family may have different likes and dislikes!






