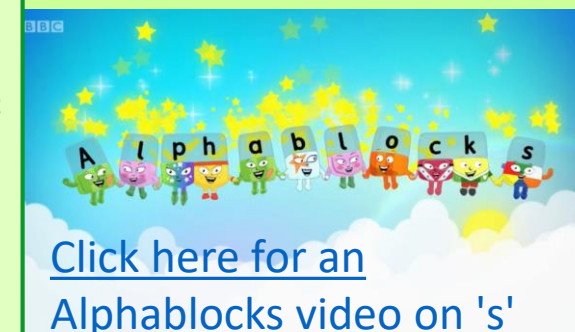
Sound of the week

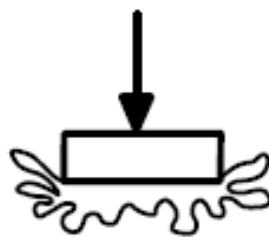

Make some Union Jack bunting or flags to hang around the house



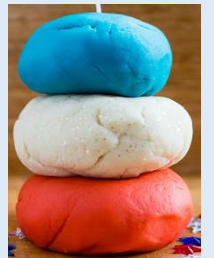
Make cakes and sandwiches and have a picnic in your house or garden - Don't forget to take photos!



Sort red, white and blue objects by their colours.

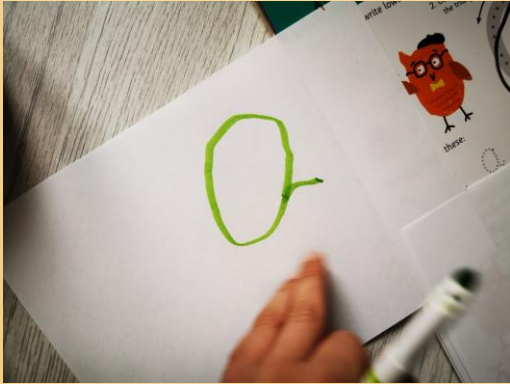


Make some sensory playdough, pasta or rice in the colour of the Union Jack
