Bucket Time Ideas:




Same /Different Ideas at Home

Humanities – Countries around the World

- Google Maps – explore satellite pictures of different countries

England:

- Flag – explore making the English flag in different ways – large red ribbons on a sheet of white paper, red finger printing onto white paper
- Food – choose traditional food to eat/ cook (eg. Fish and chips, Cornish pasties, Yorkshire puddings)
- Music- listen and dance to traditional English folk music
- Map – mark make on a map of England Clothes
- explore traditional English hats (eg. Bowler hat, flat cap)
- Landmarks – Build Stone Henge with large cardboard boxes/ building blocks
- Traditions/ festivals – have a go at Morris Dancing

Rest of the world:

Travel around the world in a role play aeroplane

Make passports and get a stamp from each country they visit

Take photos in each "country" to make into a photo album In each country explore the flag, food, music, traditional clothes, landmarks and traditions/ festivals Are there any similarities or differences with our own countries?

Examples:

China make Chinese lanterns, Chinese hats, use rice to make collages or shakers, try to pick food up with chopsticks, make flag by adding red handprint to white paper, walk along the great wall of China (use benches) **Mexico** - play with a piñata!! Make maracas and dance to Mexican music, make banjos with cardboard boxes and elastic bands, make food - fajitas, nachos, salsa, tacos etc. **Italy** - sensory play with spaghetti (wet and dry) - dye with colours of Italian flag - use to make collage of the flag, pasta - thread to make jewellery, make pizzas, build a leaning tower of Pisa using playdough - who's will fall over first?
